The McClain family will be missing their soldier this holiday season. Sergeant First Class Travis McClain was deployed to Egypt in July 2009. He is one of the 425 soldiers of the 2nd Battalion 130th Field Artillery. Hometowns of the soldiers include Atchison, Hiawatha, Holton, Horton, Marysville, Sabetha and Troy. Expected to return in June or July of 2010, families of these soldiers stay in touch in a variety of ways. Wife of SFC Travis McClain, Sam, said that she talks to her husband about every other day. However, Travis only gets to talk to his children on Saturday mornings because of the time difference and school schedules. Although, he was able to talk to his daughter, Emma, when she was in the hospital. "That instantly made her feel better!" said Sam.

Travis' first deployment was to Iraq in 2004. Sam explained that this second deployment has been especially hard because their children are older and more active and that makes her life more active. "As a military wife, I take on both parental roles in the home, on top of all the bills, housecleaning, school functions, vehicle maintenance, shopping, etc." This not

Be Prepared for Winter Weather

The winter season is fast approaching, and can bring some of the harshest weather conditions of the year with little warning — so it's important to prepare early. Be sure to have these items in your home to help keep you and your family safe in the event of a winter emergency:

- **Battery-operated items.** Keep radios and flashlights where you can find them easily — and don't forget to stock up on the batteries needed to keep them running!
- **Medications.** Be sure you have enough for several days in case you're unable to leave home.

Twitter is a social media site where you can post your ideas, opinions, and daily activities in 140

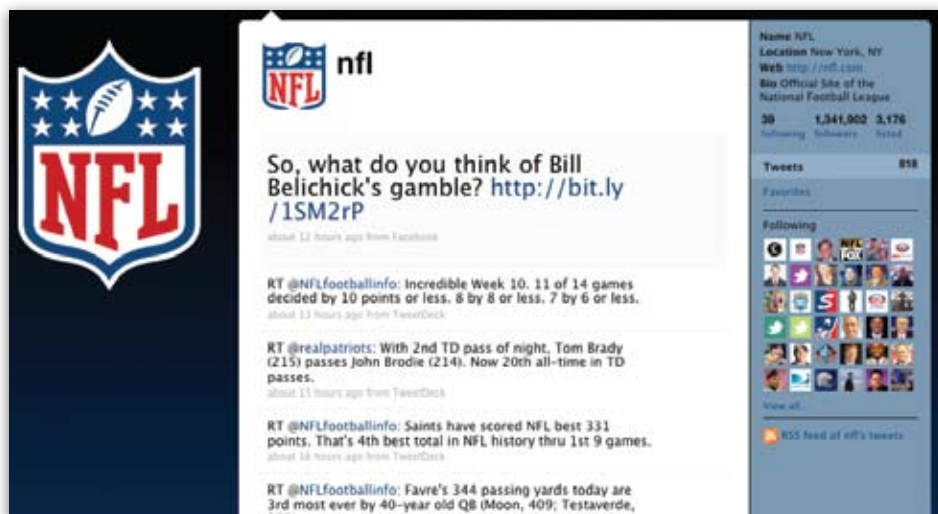
characters or less. Since its establishment in 2006, professional athletes have become regular users of the site. Because of its popularity, the National Football League (NFL) decided to regulate when athletes could and couldn't use Twitter.

The new policy prohibits players, coaches, and other team personnel from using Twitter and other social media platforms 90 minutes before the game starts

until all the media interviews are done after the game. A reason that the NFL might want to regulate the use of social media is the same as other employers. The NFL probably wants to define the line of what is appropriate representation of the league, and what is allowable as a basic constitutional freedom as an individual.

One player in particular, Chad Ochocinco (formerly Johnson), was not supportive of the NFL's Twitter regulations. An active Twitter user, Ochocinco posts approximately 30 or more posts a day. He threatened to post to his Twitter account during games. To my knowledge, he hasn't violated the regulation.

FTTH Update

Rainbow is excited to announce that the Fiber-to-the-Home cutover is now complete in Everest, Robinson, and Willis. Due to the installation of the fiber network, the residents in these areas are now able to receive faster Internet packages, up to 10Mb x 2Mb. As Bendena, Huron, and Denton residents are cut over, they also will be able to receive these faster Internet plans.

All cable has been placed and tested in the Bendena area and equipment installation should begin before the Thanksgiving holiday. Splicing for the Huron area is approximately 70 percent complete. The crews are scheduled to install the fiber equipment in Huron by the end of November with the hope of beginning the cutover during the first week of December. Denton placement is about 40 percent complete and construction for the placement will continue as long as the weather will permit.



Rural digital cable is still in the process of development for our COOP members and deployment of this service may be as early as Spring 2010.
